The tickets will be R30 per 15-minute slot. You can pay by cash or using Zapper and Snapscan. Children will need to book their specific time slots. Please encourage them to plan ahead with their friends and to book their times together.

There will be 2 teams comprising of 10 players each, every 15 minutes. Once a slot has been booked, we more than likely will not be able to change that booking if they want to play with a friend at another time. So please come prepared. We encourage families to challenge other families. We will also need some parents to challenge our teachers and we are in for a treat when Mrs. Meiring and Mr. Pugh's grade 7 teams go head to head in the Meiring and Pugh challenge at 6pm.

To keep everyone busy and add to the fun, there will also be a bull ride- and as always, tons of prizes up for grabs for that and the Laser Tag.

We will also be selling food and running our tuck-shop and Michelle from The Perfect Cup will be there to ensure you get your caffeine fix to give you that extra boost for your game.
